



## Maintenance Steering Group 3 (MSG-3), Maintenance Programme and Reliability Training Course

This 5-day course is developed to provide a solid basis for those who manage, supervise and administer large aeroplane Maintenance Programmes.

It will provide a historical review of the maintenance programme evolution and detailed explanation of Maintenance Steering Group (MSG-3) processes and techniques as well as all the mandatory maintenance requirements which are related to the aircraft design requirements.

This course will also explain in details the principal processes associated with the establishment of reliability programmes.

- familiarise candidates with the documents necessary for the effective management of maintenance programmes including the MRB report, MPD and approved maintenance schedule (AMS)
- familiarise candidates with the establishment of an effective reliability programme and the essential elements that should be included in such a programme
